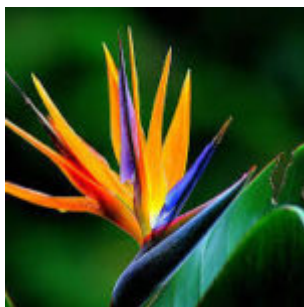
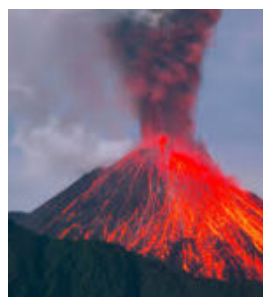
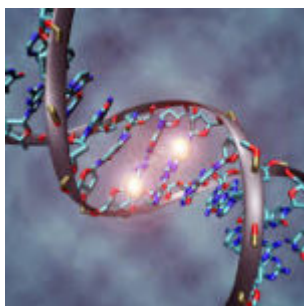


THE TRINITARIAN MUSICAL
