So, it's just common sense! To experience fulfillment in the adventures of living one must learn and practice the Basics of Life! About these Jesus claimed to be the inside scoop.


"I am the way of the truth about life!"

Customer satisfaction is essential for success in business.


"Research has shown that dissatisfied customers are likely to tell ten other people of their unfortunate experience."


A famous author wrote:

Obviously, we must know something about God if we are to know anything about ourselves!

Held every January in Detroit, Michigan, the North American International Auto Show is one of the world's premier public events, attracting nearly one million visitors. Though generating \$2 million at its glitzy charity ball, the primary purpose of the affair is to unveil new models.

Over two thousand years ago a model debut occurred that impacted the whole world. It was so momentous that it altered calendar dating from BC to AD. The event, of course, was the birth of Jesus. In a Bethlehem stable, a most unlikely venue for such an auspicious unveiling, the Maker of Life revealed His authentic design for human living ... the Model of Life. He's the Creator's Prototype of Humanness! He's the Original Human Being! He's the Pattern of Humanity! So, you need not be "in the dark" about the Maker's purpose for your life! "To be mature is to be basic. Christ! No more, no less." 16 "It's through Jesus that we find out who we are." 17

GPS (Global Positioning System) is a common feature on cell phones. With it you can be guided anywhere. Directions are provided both visually and verbally. And, if you mistakenly or willfully choose the wrong road, the program will immediately reveal your mistake and provide a course correction.



We're all seeking happiness. However, most of us are clueless about the best route, the one that guarantees optimum fulfillment ... eternal life.

So, we waste time and energy on detours that only lead to increasing levels of disappointment, frustration and emptiness. Aware of our situation, the Maker designed a Life Guidance System, LGS, called "The Jesus Journey".

Originally "Jesus recruited a band of twelve to be his traveling companions." "Come, follow ME!" On this journey Jesus is the North Star, the only point of navigation required.

That's the Life Guidance System. And, here's the best news. LGS is a free gift from the Creator! All that's required is connection to the system.

connection to jesus

God gave us eternal life; this life is in his Son. So, whoever has the Son has life; whoever rejects the Son, rejects life. $1 \cdot 10hn \cdot 5:11-12$

Imagine a solid gold table lamp. It has a cord at the end of which is a plug designed for connection to an energized receptacle. However, the expensive lamp is UNplugged. It can be seen and handled. But, from the perspective of purpose the gadget is LIFE-LESS! It merely exists. Everything changes when the cord is plugged in.

Energized the lamp fulfills its purpose. The conclusion is simple: connection means power for purpose whereas separation

signifies a lifeless existence!

"God gave us eternal (living at 100% satisfaction)

life; this life is in his Son." ²⁵ Provided by the Maker, Jesus is the source of power uniquely generated for humankind. "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never become hungry..." ²⁶ "God invented us as a man invents an engine. A car is made to run on gasoline. It would not run properly on anything else. God designed the human machine to run on Himself. He Himself is the fuel our spirits were designed to burn." ²⁷

"So, whoever has the Son has life...." "Jesus said to the fishermen, 'Come, follow ME!' At once they left and went with him." 29 "When we are called to follow Jesus, we are summoned to an exclusive attachment to his person." 30

"Jesus came into the created universe, bringing with him new life. Everyone who gets it gets it by personal contact with Him." 31

Getting connected to others via phone, computer, car, train, or plane is costly. Attachment to your Maker is "free of charge"! Just get connected to Jesus.

"But wait! There's more. You'll also receive LGS without charge!" It's "an offer you can't refuse"!

mechanics of life faith in jesus

We live by faith, not by sight. 2 Corinthians 5:7

If you spent money today, you operated by faith! A one dollar bill is only paper. Nonetheless, it has power.

Why? Note the words "The United States of America". They represent the authority of the federal government. Second, observe

the words "Federal Reserve Note".

The government promises that your piece of paper has \$1 worth of purchasing power. The third element is trust. If neither the seller nor buyer has trust in the governing authority, the paper becomes worthless! Finally, the system requires action: selling and buying.

These are the mechanics of faith: authority, promise, trust and action.





A rather humorous Bible story demonstrates faith. Abraham and Sarah had been childless their entire marriage. At age 75 Abraham was promised a baby boy by the Maker. Sarah laughed at the promise. Can you blame her? Nonetheless,

"The Lord was good to Sarah and kept his promise. Although Abraham was 100 years old, Sarah had a son exactly at the time God had said. Abraham named his son İsaac (meaning he laughs)."³²

Years later Paul commented: "Abram never wavered in believing God's promise. He was fully convinced that God has the power to do whatever he promises."33

God, the governing authority, made a promise to Abraham who trusted the promise. We're left with action. Inquiring minds want to know: what exactly did Abraham and Sarah DO for 25 years? Get it? The Maker is not a killjoy, lacking a sense of humor. Just ask old Abraham and Sarah! Oh, by the way, undoubtedly God got the last laugh!

medicine of life

grace of jesus

"God is love." Humans were designed to love and be loved! Jesus confirmed this: "Love God ... and love your neighbor as you love yourself." ³⁵

Observe the Middle East today! Obviously, humankind is NOT loving! The Manual renders this diagnosis: "Everyone sins! Everyone falls short of God's glorious design!"³⁶ The virus of sin has caused a major malfunction in the human spirit so that we "fall short" of loving God, others and self. We're diseased and the disease is deadly! "We are dead because of our sins...."³⁷ Like the UNplugged solid gold lamp we exist but are unable to fulfill our destiny!

Though our prognosis is bleak, we're not hopeless! Father has created a medicine to cure our dis-ease.

Blood is red in appearance; yet, it contains white blood cells. When your body is under a viral assault, white blood cells attack the virus. However, in gaining victory they die. Healing is won via death!

We are saved by grace through faith - a gift from God.

Ephesians 2:8





Father's medicine is similar! Jesus died to destroy the virus of sin! "Jesus was handed over to die because of our sins." Our healing was accomplished through his death. "We are healed by the wounds he suffered, made whole by the blows he received." 39

Father's medicine is called

GRACE: God's Restoration At Christ Expense!
"We are saved (the meaning of the word is "made
whole") by grace...." The old hymn calls it "amazing"!
Why? Whereas grace is extremely costly ("You were
rescued by the precious blood of Christ" 40), yet, it's "a gift
from God"!

How does one obtain the Medicine of Life? "Jesus said, 'Who needs a doctor: the healthy or the sick? I'm here inviting the sin-sick, not the spiritually-fit'."⁴¹

intimacy with jesus

A branch must stay connected to the vine to bear fruit. It is the same with you. John 15:4

Food, water and sleep! These are the basics for maintaining physical life. What's required to maintain connection to Jesus? Step Eleven of Alcoholics Anonymous provides a clue: "Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God ..."⁴²



Listening to the radio requires TUNING. The receiver is tuned to the specific frequency of the desired source. If one likes The Grand Ole Opry, one would tune to WSM 650 AM. To maintain connection to Jesus requires tuning of the heart and mind. This is accomplished primarily through prayer and meditation.

In the Bible "meditate" is a rather humorous picture word. Literally it means: a cow chewing its cud. So, meditation is the act of chewing a portion of the Bible over and over until it becomes a part of us. "Let the word of Jesus dwell in you, enriching your life and making you wise."⁴³

Prayer is conversation. Jesus taught us how to begin: "Our Father ..." ⁴⁴ Praying is both speaking and listening to our Father. He knows us better than we know ourselves. "You shaped me inside and out." ⁴⁵ So, no subject is "off limits"! If it concerns you, it concerns Him! Furthermore, prayer can take place anytime and anywhere. And yes, questions are encouraged!

Combining prayer with meditation is the preferred method. For example, the Manual talks about the use of money. So, it's best to chew on its financial instruction while having a conversation with Father about your own finances.

Remember, "A branch must stay connected to the vine to bear fruit."

LOVE IS God's Manner of Living. It's His characteristic way of acting. Jesus is the proof!

"God loved the world this way: he gave his only son."46 Loving IS Giving! At Christmas we seem to get it. Yet, in the long run "love is the only thing there's just too little of!"47 Where's the problem?

Hours before his death Jesus provided a clue. "Unless a grain of wheat is buried in the ground, it's never more than one grain of wheat. But if it is buried, it sprouts and reproduces itself many times over. Right now I am storm-tossed. What am I going to say? 'Father, get me out of this'? No, this is my purpose. I'll say, 'Father, put your glory on display through me." 48

Jesus was a "human-being-seed", filled with "all of God's character."⁴⁹ His purpose was to display "the extravagant dimensions of God's love"⁵⁰. Yet, he struggled. "Right now I am Storm-tossed." Why? His fulfillment, like a seed, would only come via the route of surrender: giving his heart away for the wellbeing of others, "sinners"⁵¹ and "enemies".⁵²



Love is risky business! "Love means to commit oneself without guarantee, to give oneself completely" To love at all is to be vulnerable. Love anything, and your heart will certainly be wrung and possibly be broken. If you want to make sure of keeping it intact, you must give your heart to no one. Avoid all entanglements; lock it up safe in the casket of selfishness." 54


Living is Loving (Giving)! Anything less is mere existence devoid of satisfaction.

God chose us to bear the family likeness of his Son. Romans 8:29

"Attached to Jesus, you are a unique masterpiece." 55 Yet, "God chose us to bear the family likeness of his Son..." 56 So, the genuine YOU is JESUS-LIKE!

I have bad news! Because we crave acceptance, we permit parents, peers, pressures and the public to define us. Consequently, Father's original design is hidden beneath layers (like an onion) of false fabrication. In the process of conforming we lose our true identity.

Don't panic! The Creator possesses the original blueprint of YOU! "Define yourself radically as one beloved by God. This is the true self. Every other identity is illusion." This is the first step of self-discovery.

Secondly, become acquainted with THE Measure. Liquids are measured in ounces, pints, quarts and gallons. "Grow in ... understanding your Master and Savior, Jesus Christ." "It is when I turn to Christ, when I give myself up to His Personality, that I first begin to have a real personality of my own." As you employ meditation and prayer the Mentor is on 24/7 duty to guide you in discovering the Jesus-Like YOU!

Finally, slowly begin to examine yourself. "God is patient. He wants you to have an opportunity to change the way you think and act." What thoughts, actions and words are Jesus-like? Label these: "the real me"! Anything that doesn't measure up to Jesus is a distorted fabrication. If you need help, ask Father: "Investigate my life. See for yourself whether I've done anything unlike Jesus. Then guide me on the road to the fulfilled life." 61

George Washington, the first president of the United States, was serious about "measuring up"! He prayed: "Daily frame me more and more into the likeness of thy son Jesus Christ." 62


You are together the body of Christ, and individually you are members of him.

The storyline of The Ten Commandments is from the Bible. God miraculously delivers the Jews from 400 years of bondage for one reason: "They'll realize that I ... brought them out of Egypt so that I could live with them." After liberation the Jews are immediately instructed to build a transportable tent. "The people must make a Tent for me, so that I may live among them." When construction was complete, God moved in. "The Glorious Presence of God filled The Dwelling." Then God said: "The twelve tribes of Israel are to set up camp around my Tent."

What was vaguely illustrated in Exodus was fulfilled in Jesus. "The infinite Life of God took shape before us" and "fixed His tent of flesh among us; and we saw His glory." That's why Jesus was called "Immanuel," which means "God is with us."

After Jesus "moved into the neighborhood" 69 "he chose twelve disciples to be with Him" 24/7.



You've just been introduced to the CHURCH as designed by Jesus! It's a Community of Life; liberated persons connected to and camped around Jesus 24/7.


ministry with jesus

As the Father sent me, so I am sending you. John 20:21

The CHURCH is like a wagon wheel. It is people (spokes) attached to Jesus (hub), kept in alignment with Him and each other by the Mentor (the outer rim). A wheel is designed for movement!

"As the Father sent me...." Jesus was on A Mission from God. When he called his twelve friends, he gave but one instruction: "Come, FOLLOW me!" Whenever and wherever Jesus went, the twelve followed (it's estimated that Jesus walked 3,125 mi during his three years of ministry). Most likely he originated the song, "On the Road Again". 73





"God showed his love for us when he sent Jesus ... to give us life." Jesus was the Father's Emergency Medical Service, dispensing the Medicine of Life: healing the dis-eased (physical, mental, spiritual, relational), rescuing the lost, mending the broken, embracing the outcast, clothing the naked, feeding the hungry, befriending the lonely, promoting justice for those falsely accused, mourning with those who grieve, liberating those demon possessed, freeing the imprisoned, offering hope to those in despair.

"So I am sending you." "The person who trusts me will not only do what I'm doing but even greater things, because I, on my way to the Father, am giving you the same work to do that I've been doing. Whatever you request along the lines of who I am and what I am doing, I'll do it." The church is nothing less than a movement of ministry, doing the stuff Jesus did, so that people experience "life that is full and good!"

The belly button marks the place at which the nutritional "life line" from your mother was

attached to you. This permanent scar is a reminder of a profound truth: life is a GIFT! Grace is given to us through Jesus (the umbilical cord) so that we are enabled to achieve the purpose for which the Creator designed us.

Fundamentally, Father loans you three commodities: Time, Talent and Treasure. "It's like a man going on a trip. He called his servants and loaned them money to invest for him while he was gone."⁷⁸

TIME! How many days will you live? Obviously, you don't know! What you do know is this: when you wake up in the morning, your 'alive-ness" is a gift. You neither earned nor purchased it. So, "teach us to use wisely all the time we have."⁷⁹

TALENT! Consider your unique personality and talent mix. Did you purchase it/them at Niemen Marcus? Here's what the Manual says. "You shaped me first inside, then out; you formed me in my mother's womb." 80

TREASURE! Much advertising appeals to our sense of entitlement. "You've work long and hard! You deserve this!" However, a smidgen of honesty reveals the truth. Yes, we work hard; but WITH the time and talent that have grace-fully been given! "Every good endowment that we possess and every complete gift that we have received comes from the Father above." 81

"Sometime later the master returned and called them to give an account of how they had used his money." As with any financier Father wants a return on his investment.

How's your account in His portfolio?

Watch one evening of local, national and international news. EVIL is on the move before our eyes!

The Manual identifies the source of evil. "Jesus turned to Peter and said, 'Get behind Me, Satan! You're in my way!"⁸³ "Satan is ... an angel (spirit being) who rebelled against God. His goal is to lead people away from (backwards) the love of God; i.e., to lead them to evil."⁸⁴

"The word 'evi' is the word 'ive' spelled backwards." 85 Though possessing a reverse gear, an automobile is designed to move forward. Imagine a person, ignoring a car's design, driving down the expressway in reverse! Destruction guaranteed!

Jesus came to give you "abundant life" ... ultimate satisfaction, fulfillment and happiness! On the other hand Satan tempts you 24/7 to choose REVERSE. His "purpose is to steal, destroy and kill" every feature of Father's design for your life.

Satan has many strategies. "Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against ALL strategies of the devil."86 However, his primary tool is deception. "Your father, the devil, is the father of lies." 87 "The ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, the one deceiving the whole world—was thrown down to the earth ..."88

ISIS confronts people with a choice: "follow us or die!" Satan is no less atrocious with his demands! But remember; he's a Liar! Only


Jesus is "the Way to the Truth about Life!"89



Memorial Day was birthed in May of 1865 by a group of freed slaves in Charleston, South Carolina. They visited a cemetery for Union soldiers, decorating their graves to Remember:

FREEDOM is not FREE!

Israel received this instruction for the eve of their liberation. "Each Jewish man is to take a lamb for his family and slaughter it at dusk. He must take some of the blood and smear it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the house in which his family will eat the meat, along with bread. This will be a memorial day for you..." Remember:

FREEDOM is not FREE!



"On the eve of his crucifixion Jesus took bread. When He had given thanks, He broke it and said, 'Take this bread and eat it. This is my body which is broken for you. Do this to remember ME.' After supper, He took the cup. He said, 'This cup is the New Way of Relationship between God and you via my blood. Whenever you drink it, do it to remember ME." Remember: FREEDOM is not FREE!

"Every time you eat this bread and drink from this cup you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes again." Jesus will return with the Father's new production, "a new heaven and a new earth."
